IDLEWILD ENVIROMENTAL DAMAGE COMPLIANCE DEPOSITS IDLEWILD IMPACT FEES EFFECTIVE APRIL 25, 2023

Trucks carrying heavy loads of asphalt, concrete, gravel, drywall, lumber, and other building materials to construction sites cause excessive wear and damage to Idlewild roads. To recover expenses for road maintenance and repairs resulting from these heavy loads, the Architectural and Environmental Committee (AEC) of the Idlewild Property Owners Association has recommended and the Idlewild Property Owners Association Board of Directors has approved the following schedule of nonrefundable fees for construction projects. These fees will be specifically used to pay expenses for the maintenance and repair of roads in Idlewild.

In addition to the nonrefundable fees, a partially or fully refundable Environmental Damage and Compliance Deposit (EDCD) is required before construction of some projects can begin or before more than 4,000 pounds of household goods can be transported in a single load to or from an existing house in Idlewild. A nonrefundable portion of this deposit (if any) will be used to pay expenses for repairs to roads, drainage ditches, culverts, or greenways resulting from adverse environmental or structural damage caused by contractors during construction or trucks hauling household goods. Trucks that exceed 20 feet in length, whether carrying construction equipment or household goods, are highly likely to cause road and culvert damage on tight turns or while backing into driveways. If the Idlewild AEC observes environmental and/or structural damage caused by activities directly related to a project such as construction or moving household goods, the lot owner will be asked to contact the responsible entity and request remediation of the damage. The EDCD will be used to pay for repairs not covered by contractors.
